# Principal's Report

Dear Families,

Welcome to Term 2 at Noranda Primary School. It is great to hear so many of our students had a relaxing and fun school holidays.

#### **Faction Carnival**

Students are asked to wear their faction shirts (plain coloured t-shirt without logos) and school shorts, skorts or skirts. Students must have their school hats and sneakers. #### **WA Student Assistance Payment**

Applications for the WA Student Assistance Payment opened Monday, 28 April and close on Friday, 4 July. Available for students in Kindy through to Year 12.

Student number will be required to make the claim which is located on students Smart Rider, Semester report and NAPLAN report. You can also contact the office for the number to be provided to you.

The fastest way to claim is through the ServiceWA app. \$150 for students attending primary school or Kindergarten and \$250 for secondary students. To claim the payments, parents and carers are encouraged to set up a ServiceWA account. More information is available at <a href="wa.gov.au/servicewaapp">wa.gov.au/servicewaapp</a>. All claims must be received by Friday 4 July 2025.

#### **Enrolments 2026**

Registrations are invited for **Kindergarten** and **Pre-Primary** (not already enrolled at Noranda PS Kindergarten) for 2026. Application forms are available from the office between 9:00am and 2:00pm.

Children born between 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022 are eligible for Kindergarten.

#### Applications close Friday 25 July 2025.

You will be asked to show your child's Birth Certificate (original or certified copy) or birth extract or equivalent identity documents; your child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement (downloaded through myGov); proof of your child's usual place of residence e.g. utilities account, lease agreement, statutory declaration and copies of any Family Court or other court orders and visa details (if applicable).

Principals may accept a maximum of three documents as evidence of your child's usual residential address. Principals are able to request additional information where this is necessary to confirm your child's usual place of residence.

You will need to provide evidence of your child's current immunisation status when you lodge an application to enrol. You can provide one of the following:

- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement that is not more than two months old; or
- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Form for children on a catch-up schedule that is not more than six months old; or

• Immunisation Certificate issued by the Chief Health Officer.

Other immunisation documents are no longer accepted.

Once the application has been accepted, you will be required to complete an Enrolment Form. If your Application for Enrolment is not accepted, you will be advised in writing within three weeks of the advertised closing date for applications.

This is also the time to enrol your child to High School for Year 7 for 2026.

#### Anzac Service

Before the holidays we held our Anzac Service. The Student Councillors lead the ceremony with confidence and dignity. We were fortunate to have Major Ned Robinson join us and address the students. Major Robinson is a parent of one of our students and we thank him for giving us his time.
