Dear Families,

Athletics

We have had a fabulous start to our term with our Faction Carnival in week one. Thank you so much to the staff for making it such an enjoyable day for our students. Through physical education lessons with Mr O'Callaghan and junior and senior sport sessions, our students were well placed to participate in the variety of activities on the day. Thank you also to our P & C who coordinated Subway lunches and the Bake Sale.

Last week, we hosted the Interschool Jumps and Throws at Noranda and it was great to see our students so competitive on the day. Tomorrow is the Interschool Athletics carnival at Hillcrest Primary School. Our students will compete throughout the day in sprints, relays and team games. I am sure our students will make us proud on the day.

School Board Meeting

Our School Board met last night and looked at a range of student achievement data. We looked at the preliminary NAPLAN results and saw that our preliminary results are positive.

The like schools results are not yet available so we cannot determine whether our Business Plan targets have been met this year. Our median score for all 8 assessments falls within the 'strong' proficiency, which is the second highest proficiency. We will have more information when the final results come through, hopefully later this term, along with Parent reports.

Parents & Citizens Meeting

The P & C also met last night. This was a planning session for upcoming P & C events as well as a reflection upon what has been conducted in 2025 thus far. All parents are welcome to come along to P & C meetings, you do not have to be a committee member to attend. The next meeting will be on Wednesday June 11th at 7pm.

Enrolments 2026

Registrations are invited for **Kindergarten** and **Pre-Primary** (not already enrolled at Noranda PS Kindergarten) for 2026. Application forms are available from the office between 9:00am and 2:00pm.

Children born between 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022 are eligible for Kindergarten.

Applications close Friday 25 July 2025.

You will be asked to show your child's Birth Certificate (original or certified copy) or birth extract or equivalent identity documents; your child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement (downloaded through myGov); proof of your child's usual place of residence e.g. utilities account, lease agreement, statutory declaration and copies of any Family Court or other court orders and visa details (if applicable).

Principals may accept a maximum of three documents as evidence of your child's usual residential address. Principals are able to request additional information where this is necessary to confirm your child's usual place of residence.

You will need to provide evidence of your child's current immunisation status when you lodge an application to enrol. You can provide one of the following:


- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement that is not more than two months old; or
- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Form for children on a catch-up schedule that is not more than six months old; or
- Immunisation Certificate issued by the Chief Health Officer.

Other immunisation documents are no longer accepted.

Once the application has been accepted, you will be required to complete an Enrolment Form. If your Application for Enrolment is not accepted, you will be advised in writing within three weeks of the advertised closing date for applications.

This is also the time to enrol your child to High School for Year 7 for 2026.
