One of the highlights of the carnival was our students' outstanding performance in the Grand Relay, which we proudly won. The determination, teamwork and sportsmanship

displayed by all students throughout the day were a credit to themselves, their families and our school.

Enrolments 2027 - Now Open

Registrations are now open for Kindergarten and Pre-Primary (not already enrolled at Noranda PS Kindergarten) for 2027. Application forms are available from the office between 9:00am and 3:00pm, from our website [ENROLMENT - Noranda Primary School](#), or can be emailed.

Children born between 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 are eligible for Kindergarten.

Applications close Friday 24 July 2026.

You will be asked to provide:

- your child's Birth Certificate (original or certified copy) or birth extract or equivalent identity documents
- your child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement (downloaded in the last 2 months through myGov)
- proof of your child's usual place of residence e.g. rates notice, utilities account, lease agreement, statutory declaration

plus

- copies of any Family Court or other court orders and visa details (if applicable).

Principals may accept a maximum of three documents as evidence of your child's usual residential address. Principals are able to request additional information where this is necessary to confirm your child's usual place of residence.

You will need to provide evidence of your child's current immunisation status when you lodge an application to enrol. You can provide one of the following:

- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement that is not more than two months old; or
- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Form for children on a catch-up schedule that is not more than six months old; or
- Immunisation Certificate issued by the Chief Health Officer.

Other immunisation documents are no longer accepted.

Once the application has been accepted, you will be required to complete an Enrolment Form. If your Application for Enrolment is not accepted, you will be advised in writing.

This is also the time to enrol your child to High School for Year 7 for 2027.

Noranda Nippers

Noranda Primary School has run a very successful storytime program for several years called 'Noranda Nippers'.

The program is run on Mondays from 9:00-10:00am in Room 16. This weekly program is **for children 2-4 years**. All local families are welcome to attend. Mrs Cohen runs the group and provides suitable activities for the children.

We also provide a variety of information sessions from professionals including Early Childhood experts, speech therapists, occupational therapists, nutritionists, health nurse and more!

Fees are \$2 per child per session. These fees will cover the cost of supplies used.
